"Collapsing Distance" Through Art During winter quarter, Stanford students enrolled in a class called "Mail Art" created small works of art, remotely, during workshops led by master artists, and mailed them to classmates across the country.

### **Using Pastel with Watercolor Tutorial**

A 35-minute video demonstrating how well these two mediums work together and how beginning a pastel painting with watercolor can influence and produce a more painterly style.

#### The wildest art center in the West?



Windblown and weird, Montana's Tippet Rise Art Center features sculptures by Alexander Calder, Francis Kéré, and Stephen Talasnik amid passing elk and deer on 12,000 acres. "The remote installations each get their own canyon, hill, glade, or natural amphitheater as a frame," Nat Geo's Eve Conant wrote in 2019.
