# **November Demonstrator**

I love glass. I split my time between creating fused glass pieces and mosaic art. I started fusing about six years ago just so I could create interesting elements for my mosaics, but fusing quickly got the better of me. There is so much to learn and one of my passions is experimenting with what I can create. The possibilities seem limitless. I create indoor and outdoor, functional and non-functional works of art. My artwork is constantly evolving. Size-wize my work ranges from a 7' tall, 3-dimensional sculpture down to jewelry.

Lately, I have been working on an architectural mosaic for the back of a house. With fusing, I have been experimenting with painting with frit. (Frit is glass that can range anywhere from 1/4 inch pieces to powder.)

When I create a mosaic, what I see in my mind is exactly what I create. Fusing is a much more difficult process. Glass changes during the fusing process in the kiln. You have to anticipate the variable changes wrought by the "kiln gods."

Even so, I have a passion (or an addiction) for glass that gives me great happiness. I hope my artwork also brings happiness to those who see it.
