
Community Orchard Art Los Altos ArtVenturers Sep 30, 2021–Feb 20, 2022 J. Gilbert Smith House

Art of Anna Knapp Fitz

In 1921, eight-year-old Anna Knapp Fitz moved with her family to an eight-acre farm in Los Altos. As an adult, when asked what life was like in those early days, "Annie," as she was known, picked up her paintbrush to tell the story. This self-taught artist donated 212 of her paintings to Los Altos History Museum, which will draw from the collection for an exhibition titled "Annie Knapp Fitz Paints: A Legacy in Art," on display **Sept 9, 2021 - Feb 6, 2022.**
